WHITELEY

The new town of Whiteley was established in 1990 and Dr Roope and Partners opened a Temporary Surgery in Yew Tree Drive in 1998. From that date Studio Four were involved in assessing numerous potential sites for a permanent surgery on behalf of the GPs, all of which had to be abandoned due to Planning restrictions or cost issues. In 2002 PMP Health Developments were appointed to assist with the site search and further sites were assessed but found to be unsuitable. Finally in 2005 the Local Authority agreed that the site adjacent to the existing temporary surgery, which had been designated for further housing, could be made available to the surgery as a permanent home and in 2006 a full planning application was approved.

The proposed site was tight, bordered by protected trees and the temporary surgery had to remain open throughout construction. The scheme included the surgery, a pharmacy and a dentist. When the dentist pulled out, the area was adapted to suit Practice Based Commissioning run by the GPs. Work started on site in May 2006 and was completed in November of that year, with removal of the temporary surgery and pharmacy and construction of the car parking areas completed in February 2007.
